**INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN
CENTRALISED SINGLE WINDOW SEAT SELECTION PROCESS**

COUNSELING ANNOUNCEMENT

Karnataka Private Medical and Dental Colleges Association is holding a Centralized Counseling for admissions to Post-Graduate Medical and Dental courses of the member institutions for the academic year 2011-2012 to ensure merit based admission.

For this purpose the Association has commissioned the services of COMEDK, which has established a transparent testing system for determination of merit and conducted Post Graduate and Under Graduate Centralised counseling over the past years.

The Rank List and the Rank Card of COMEDK PGET-2011 has been generated and dispatched. Candidates who have secured (50%) and above in the COMEDK Entrance Examination (as prescribed by MCI /DCI) are only eligible for counseling. However for candidates belonging to SC, ST (All India) and OBC categories of Karnataka 40% is the minimum mark in the COMEDK Entrance Examination (as prescribed by MCI/DCI) for PG Medical & Dental Courses.

COUNSELING VENUE

NMKRV Mangala Mantapa, 3rd Block, Jayanagar, Bangalore.

Counseling schedule for each day has been notified in Appendix-I.

Note: Candidates are requested to log on to COMEDK website (www.comedk.org) frequently to check the counseling status and all updates.

Original Certificates and one set of photocopies of the following documents to be furnished compulsorily at the time of counseling (Ensure to have enough photocopies of original documents for your use):

1. COMEDK PGET-2011 Rank Card.
2. SSLC or 10th Standard or equivalent Marks Card.
3. MBBS/BDS (All Marks Card/s).
4. Internship completion Certificate / Certificate for date of completion of internship in case of candidates who have not yet completed their internship at the time of counseling (Candidates would be eligible for seat selection only if they complete their internship on or before 30/04/2011).

5. Permanent / Provisional degree certificate.
6. Permanent / Provisional State / Central Council registration Certificate (check for the renewal date of the certificate).
7. Attempt Certificate.
8. Candidates belonging to SC, ST (All India) and OBC of Karnataka would be considered, provided they furnish the following Certificates:
 - a. SC/ST: Caste Certificate issued by competent authority (Authorized to issue such a certificate but not below the rank of a Tahasildar)
 - b. OBC: Category I, IIA, IIB, IIIA, and IIIB: As notified by the Karnataka Government Caste and income Certificate issued by Tahasildar or higher revenue jurisdictional authority authorized to issue such certificate. If valid certificates are not furnished, the candidate will be considered under General Category subject to obtaining 50% and above in the Entrance Test.
 - c. MINORITY: Religious (Christian) Minority candidates of All India, Linguistics (Telugu / Tulu) Minority candidates of Karnataka to produce certificate as per **Appendix – IV**.
9. **Demand Draft to be drawn in favour of 'COMEDK' payable at Bangalore for the annual tuition fee specified along with the Bank Challan issued by the bank at the time of buying the Demand Draft.**

Note: Refund of excess amount, if any, in the Demand Draft submitted will be made after adjusting the amount to be paid for the course allotted.

The following certificates are required to be furnished at the college level at the time of admission.

1. **ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE** issued by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS), for candidates who are not students of Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS)
2. **TRANSFER CERTIFICATE**
3. **MIGRATION CERTIFICATE** for candidates of Universities other than Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS).

Note:

Candidates are cautioned to be careful about their Rank card. Candidates should note that duplicate Rank card will not be issued. However details of Rank card returned by postal authorities are updated regularly in the website. Hence such of the candidates whose Rank cards are returned can collect the same at counseling venue.

ELIGIBILITY

Medical

As per the Medical Council of India, the minimum percentage of marks in the entrance test (COMEDK PGET-2011) for eligibility for admission to Post Graduate Courses shall be 50% for General Category candidates and 40% for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes (All India) and Other Backward Classes belonging to Karnataka State.

Dental

As per the Dental Council of India, the minimum percentage of marks in the entrance test (COMEDK PGET-2011) for eligibility for admission to Post Graduate Courses shall be 50% for General Category candidates and 40% for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes (All India) and Other Backward Classes belonging to Karnataka State.

Note: Only those candidates who have completed or will be completing their Internship on or before 30/4/2011 are eligible for Centralized counseling to pursue their PG courses in Medical / Dental Stream for the academic year 2011-2012.

Note:

Candidates who have selected a seat by submitting their Original documents in the following Institutions / Universities / Agencies may attend the COMEDK Counseling, with one set of attested photocopies of documents, the acknowledgement and the allotment letter issued by them:

1. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS).
2. All India Post Graduate Medical and Dental Counseling.
3. Deemed Universities of Karnataka State only.

We will not accept any other acknowledge/Allotment letter issued by any other state/university. The admission to the post graduate course will not be entertained.

All other candidates have to show the original documents specified without which they will not be allowed to enter the Auditorium where the counseling is held.

ADMISSION FEE

Admission for Post Graduate Medical and Dental Courses is by payment of the Annual tuition fee for first year. Details are furnished in the Fee Matrix given below. Candidates will be required to pay the University Fee and any other authorised fee at the time of reporting to the college selected by the candidate.

The Annual tuition fee amount for the first year, for different courses should be paid by the candidates when they come for Centralised Counseling, in the form of a **Demand Draft drawn**

in favour of COMEDK, payable at Bangalore. The candidates should come prepared with the Demand Draft before registering themselves for selecting a seat, failing which they will not be allowed to participate / enter the counseling hall. **Cash or cheque, will not be accepted under any circumstances.**

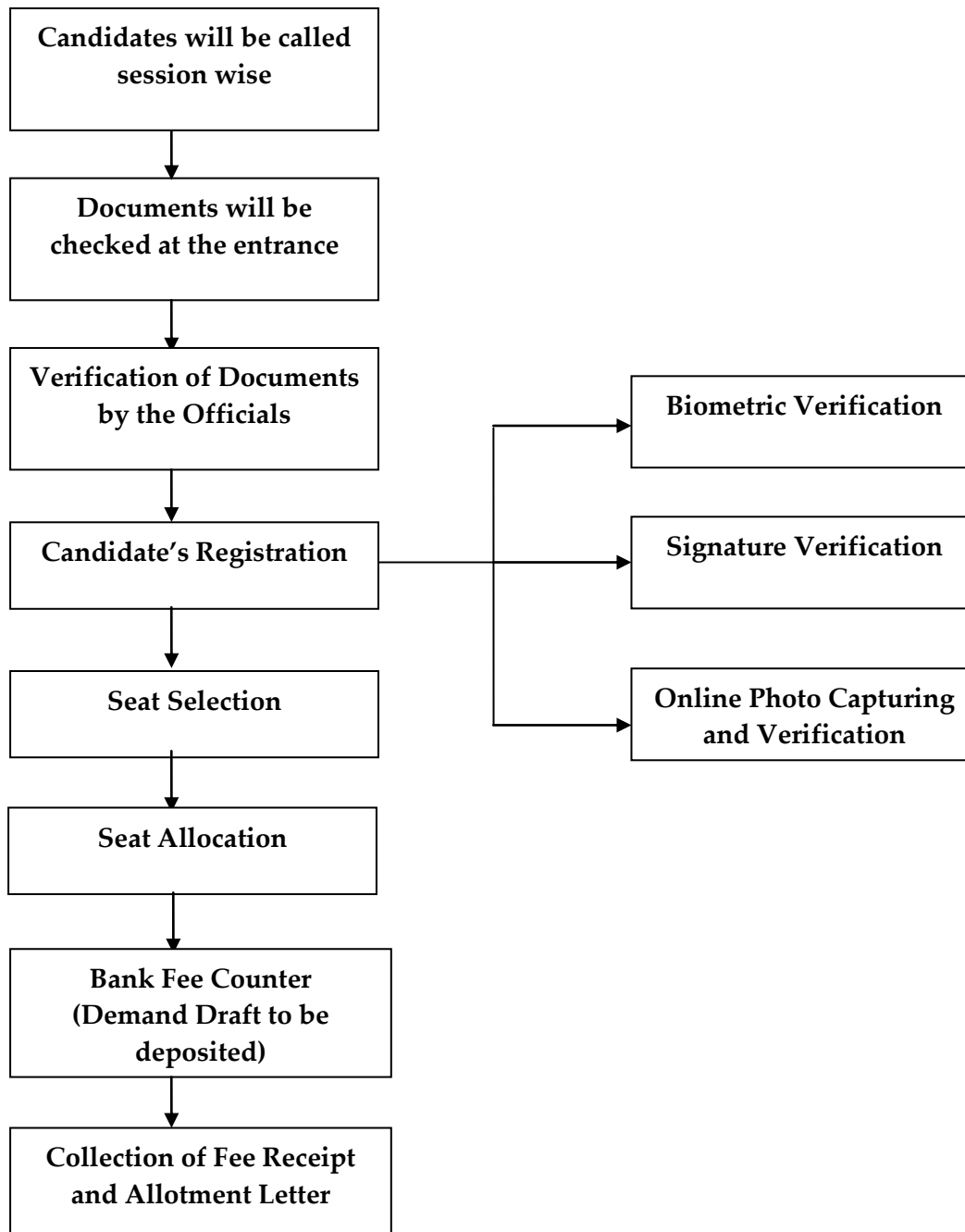

PROCEDURE OF SEAT SELECTION BY THE CANDIDATES

Selection of a seat by a candidate and admission thereafter at the COMEDK

Centralized Counseling shall comprise of the following stages:



- Verification of the Original Documents & Demand Draft
- Registration of the candidates (after Biometric, Signature and Photo Identification verifications)
- Exercising the option by the registered candidates which involves selection of seats in accordance with the order of merit
- Remittance of Fees in the form of Demand Draft at the Bank Counter
- Issue of Allotment letter

FIRST ROUND OF SEAT SELECTION

The candidates will be allowed to exercise their option and select a **seat strictly in the order of merit**. A day is divided into **six sessions** and the first session begins at **8:00AM**. The candidate will be allowed to participate in accordance with the notified time schedule and as per the stipulated rank ranges only, as per the schedule under **Appendix I**. The candidates are required to get the documents verified and later to register themselves only after Biometric, Signature and Photo Identification.

Biometric verification, photo verification and signature verification will be made and therefore the **candidate is required to be present compulsorily for seat selection process. Only one person (parent, guardian or spouse) can accompany the candidate for the entire counseling process.**

Note: Use of Cell Phone / Laptops is strictly prohibited inside the Counseling Venue.

The entire seat selection process in the COMEDK is controlled by a computer system right from the stage of registration till the stage of printing of Allotment letter. The highly sophisticated software used in the system has the ability to control the initial registration, provide data for *verification of the original documents* and to take care of the selection of the seats by the candidates in the order of merit, payment of fees and finally printing of *Provisional / Confirmed Allotment letter*. A merit list is generated for each of the session once the candidate comes to the seat selection by registering and verifying the documents, order of merit cannot be changed as it is computerized. A candidate who has the better rank gets the opportunity to select a seat. A dynamic screen will show course-wise and college-wise availability of seats, which helps the candidates to make up their mind in advance. The moment the option is exercised, the computer will show one seat less against the course/college from which the candidate has selected the seat. The candidate needs to submit all the original documents then he / she will be given a *Confirmed letter* of offer for the particular college/course along with the details of payment to be made by the candidate. The candidate then will go to the bank counter & deposit the same along with the *Demand Draft* for prescribed annual tuition fee. After this the candidate will be given a *Confirmed Allotment Letter* that he / she have to submit to the college allotted at the time of admission. If the candidate fails to submit the Original documents instead submits the acknowledgement received from any other organization where he/she is allotted a seat, will be given a *provisional letter* of offer for the particular college/course along with the details of payment to be made by the candidate. The candidate then will go to the bank counter & deposit the same

along with the *Demand Draft* for prescribed annual tuition fee. After this the candidate will be given a *Provisional Allotment Letter with an indication that it is not valid for admission*. If such a candidate does not submit all the original documents along with the *Provisional Allotment Letter* and gets the *Confirmed Allotment Letter* on or before the date which will be notified in due course, he / she is deemed to have forfeited the selected seat and the vacant seat will be offered in Final Round of counseling as per merit.

The Provisional and Confirmed Allotment letter has built in security features and cannot be duplicated. No duplicate Allotment letter will be issued for any reason. If it is found that the allotment letter issued to the candidate is tampered, the COMEDK reserves the right to cancel such allotment and withhold the fee paid.



If the original Confirmed Allotment Letter is lost, the Candidate will loose the selected seat as well. Hence the candidates are cautioned to be more careful and submit at the College while reporting.

No candidate will be allowed to change the seat once selected. Candidates are cautioned here that they have to be very careful during this process, as the computerized system cannot be reversed especially if the rank below him has already exercised his choice of seat selection.

Please Note: Once a candidate confirms the provisional allotment, further surrender of such seats is not permissible.

FINAL ROUND OF SEAT SELECTION

The Final Round seat selection process will be notified in due course. After the completion of the first round seat selection, unfilled, surrendered, forfeited, cancelled and newly added seats, if any, will be offered in Final round.

-  All candidates who have selected a seat and obtained **Confirmed allotment letters** in respect of the seat selected in the first round whether reported to the college or not, will be eligible to participate in the Final round along with candidates who have not selected any seat.
-  If the seats are remaining vacant under minority quota the first session of the final round of counseling would be for candidates belonging to Religious (Christian) / Linguistic (Tulu / Telugu) minorities of Karnataka only. If Minority seats of Father

Muller are still vacant then the Christians of other states would be counseled before it is moved to general merit category.

- ❖ Seats, if any, remaining vacant under minority quota will be moved to General Merit category. General Merit candidates are counseled as per schedule.
- ❖ Candidates who have not attended the 1st round of counseling are also eligible to participate in the Final round to choose the seats available at that stage.
- ❖ During the Final round of counseling, there is no provision to issue any provisional allotment. **Only the candidates who appear with the original documents and who are willing to submit them at the time of allotment will be counseled during the Final round.**
- ❖ The concerned colleges will later fill any seat falling vacant due to surrender or change over after the Final round of Counseling.
- ❖ The issue of Allotment letter by the COMEDK is provisional which is to enable the candidate to join the concerned college, subject to his meeting all the eligibility requirements as prescribed by MCI / DCI and the concerned university in Karnataka. Hence at the college level all the original documents are once again verified before acceptance.

Grounds of Reject:

- ❖ If on verification the documents are not found to be in order or on falsification of documents or the expert committee is not convinced about the genuineness of the documents submitted at the verification counter such of the candidate will be rejected.
- ❖ If there is a mismatch of photo, finger impression and signature of the candidate or if there is a reasonable doubt by the expert committee that there is malified intent of impersonation, such of the candidate/s will be debarred and criminal proceedings may be initiated. **The decision of the expert committee will be final in this regard.** This will also be notified to the MCI/DCI for further action.
- ❖ **Candidate must be physically present and no proxy registration is possible (Medical certificates / affidavits will not be accepted for the same).**

5. LATECOMER POLICY

Candidate who fails to report in time at the venue as per their date and time of the schedule will be considered as a latecomer, he / she will be counseled only in the next session and is eligible to be counseled as the first candidate of that session and only be entitled for seat selection amongst the seats available at that point of counseling.

6. REFUND AND FORFEITURE OF FEE

- ❑ Only the candidate can surrender the seat in person at the Counseling venue / COMEDK Office (no surrender will be accepted through Authorization, Phone, FAX, E-Mail or Post). Such of the candidates are required to bring original allotment letter, Bank receipt and Verification card received by them.
- ❑ If any candidate is permitted to change the college or course during the Final round of counseling, it will not result in any loss of fee but will be adjusted with necessary refund by crossed A/c payee cheque in the **name of the candidate only** or collection (DD in favour of COMEDK payable at Bangalore) of difference of fee as applicable to the course or college.
- ❑ Any candidate who surrenders his Provisional / Confirmed Allotment on or before the date fixed, will be refunded the fee paid after deducting Rs.1, 000/- being administrative expenses. Remaining amount will be refunded as crossed A/c payee cheque in the **name of the candidate only**. Such of the candidates are required to bring original allotment letter, Bank receipt and Verification card received by them.
- ❑ Any candidate who fails to surrender the seat on or before **the date which will be notified in due course** without converting the provisional allotment into the confirmed allotment will forfeit not only the allotted seat but also will be liable to pay a penalty of Rs.50,000/- in the fee that is already paid. Refund of the remaining amount will be made available by crossed A/c payee cheque in the name of the candidate.

The higher penalty has been decided by the COMEDK advisory committee in order to prevent candidates holding on to their allotted seats / misuse of such seats / blocking the merit seats. This is only to facilitate the merited students, the decision of higher penalty of Rs. 50,000 / - has been enforced. However such seats would be deemed to be forfeited and would be added for final round of counseling.

❖ Surrender of seat by the candidates possessing confirmed Allotment Letter is not allowed at COMEDK either during or after the Final round of counseling. They are required to do so at the respective college selected by them and allotted accordingly. COMEDK will not be responsible for any consequences. Candidates have to approach the college concerned.

7. LEGAL JURISDICTION

Any dispute that may arise in respect of the seat selection process and admission is subject to the jurisdiction of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka and consumer court of Bangalore. The issue of Allotment letter by the COMEDK is provisional which is to enable the candidate to join the concerned college, subject to his meeting all the eligibility requirement as prescribed by MCI / DCI as well as the concerned University in Karnataka. Hence at the college level all the original documents are once again verified before acceptance, including biometric, photo and signature verification. Language of communication must be only in English.

ATTENTION:

Only genuine and bonafide candidates possessing original documents are allowed for counseling.

Persons attempting impersonation and / or producing of duplicate / color Xeroxed / fake documents and such others acts will draw the candidates to be debarred from counseling process at any stage and will be severely dealt with including handing over to law enforcing authorities.

Touts and agents, if found accompanying the candidate's, such candidates will also be debarred from the counseling process.

All candidates must note that any form of canvassing or influence exercised would result in permanent disqualification. <http://www.comedk.org> is the only official website of the Consortium. COMEDK is not responsible for information available on other websites / elsewhere.

Please Note: COMEDK does not have any agents, liaison, admission offices, representatives or any other office/s other than the office mentioned in this document. Candidates are requested not to depend upon or deal with any person or organisation/s claiming to be associated with the COMEDK activities or claiming to help with admissions or entrance tests. COMEDK will not be responsible for the same.

8. ASSISTANCE

Candidates seeking any clarification or assistance for specific problems with regard to the seat selection process are required to contact COMEDK Office well in advance for redressal. COMEDK suggest all the candidates to visit the COMEDK website regularly for the latest updates.
