COMEDK's UGET 2023: Revision in upper limit of Annual Tuition Fee- reg.

COMEDK, vide notification dtd. 10.06.2023 had notified the details regarding the conduct of the Counseling Process besides publishing the Counseling Process Document on 11.06.2023.

In the notification dtd. 09.06.2023, it was also informed that the tuition fee for the academic year 2023-24 has been increased by 10% over and above the fee of last year. There are two types of upper limits in tuition fee that can be opted by the institutions which is linked to the fees that is opted by them in KCET which was Rs. 2,44,372/- p.a. and Rs. 1,73,936/- p.a.

Subsequently, keeping in view the interest of the student community, the Association of Colleges and Government have deliberated on the issue of increase of tuition fee and it has been decided that the increase of upper limits of tuition fee should be at 7% over and above the fee of last year instead of 10%.

Accordingly, the upper limits of the Annual Tuition Fee has been revised as follows:

- 1) Rs. 2,37,706/- p.a. and
- 2) Rs. 1,69,192/- p.a.

In view of the above, we have been receiving requests about refund of the difference amount from the candidates who have obtained the seats through COMEDK.

In this regard, it is hereby informed that by the time the revision of the upper limit of Annual Tuition Fee happened, COMEDK had already crossed halfway in the Counseling process and owing to the technicalities, the database cannot be changed in the middle of the process.

Therefore, the candidates who have reported to the college and continuing the study and candidates who will report to the college and continue the study after Round2 Phase2 and Round3 may approach the concerned college authorities for refund/adjustment of the difference in upper limit of tuition fees after the completion of the COMEDK counseling process and subsequent to the reconciliation of the data.

All other terms & conditions brought out in the Counseling Process Document dtd. 11.06.2023 and related notifications will prevail to the extent not contrary to this notification.
