The candidates who want to register afresh have to fill the online application with a payment of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) as application fee. The list of colleges who are accepting the counseling and allotment process of COMEDK during this year along with the indicative number of seats and the tuition fee for the same would be notified on COMEDK website separately. The candidates are required to refer to the COMEDK website (www.comedk.org) for all updates.

GUIDELINES

Candidates are expected to go through the COMEDK UGET 2023 Brochure, Counselling Process Document 2023, related notifications and understand the process before applying for Architecture counselling. COMEDK suggests all the candidates to visit the COMEDK website www.comedk.org regularly for all updates and notifications.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ARCHITECTURE COUNSELLING

Eligibility Criteria: As per the revised eligibility criteria of Council of Architecture:

- I. The candidate needs to qualify an aptitude test in Architecture conducted either by JEE (National Testing Agency) or NATA (National Aptitude Test in Architecture) conducted by the Council of Architecture
The candidates will have option of entering scores of NATA and JEE Paper-2 if they have appeared for both. COMEDK will consider the scores of any one entrance test whichever is beneficial to the candidate. If the candidates have appeared for only one exam, they have to enter the marks of that particular exam only.
- II. Must have passed 12th Std /2nd PUC/ Equivalent Exam with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with either Chemistry/Biology/Technical Vocational subject/Computer Science/Information Technology/Informatics Practice/Engineering Graphics/Business Studies OR passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as a compulsory subject.
- III. Candidate should have Minimum 45% percentage overall in 12th/2nd PUC/Diploma/Equivalent exam.
- IV. COMEDK will NOT conduct a separate entrance test for admission to B.Arch.

RANKING

- 1) A Rank Card will be generated only for those candidates who become eligible for admission to Under Graduate Courses as per the regulations of COA /AICTE/ VTU and whose document verification is successful/approved.
- 2) A Rank list will be generated by considering 50% weightage to B. Arch Entrance Exam (i.e. NATA or JEE) and 50% weightage to 12th/2nd PUC/Diploma percentage
- 3) Those who have written both NATA & JEE, best of the percentage will be considered
- 4) Candidates are cautioned to enter the correct marks details and upload proper score card of the same, since the rank card will be generated based on the same. Once the rank is generated, it will not be revised under any circumstances.

In case of a 'Tie', the following tie breaker rules will be applied:

- a) Higher percentage in Architecture entrance exam (i.e NATA or JEE)
- b) Higher percentage in 12th/ 2nd PUC/ Diploma as applicable.
- c) Higher percentage of Mathematics Marks in 12th/2nd PUC/Diploma
- d) Older candidate will be ranked higher

Completing Online Application Form for Architecture Counselling

- Candidates who have already applied by paying Rs. 2000/- and their documents are verified need not register again. Such candidates, if they have attempted JEE (Paper 2) or NATA 3 should send their JEE and NATA 3 score card to the email id: documents@comedk.org
- Only Fresh candidates need to fill the Counselling Application for Architecture Online
- The process involves registering and completing the counselling application form, Uploading the required documents for Architecture and paying Rs 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) during the prescribed time as per counselling schedule for Architecture available on www.comedk.org. Please note convenience charges on transaction will be additional
- This fee is non-refundable under any circumstance including statutory reasons

- 9) **SC/ST/OBC Certificate & Domicile Certificate/ Improvement or Supplementary Marksheet or any other document** (If applicable)
- 10) **KKR/HKR Certificate (371J)**: Candidates claiming KKR/HKR seat should upload KKR/HKR certificate. Should be in the name of the candidate, issued by Asst. Commissioner in charge of Revenue sub division
- 11) **Domicile Certificate**: Should be in the name of the candidate. Issued by Revenue authority not below the rank of Tahsildar.

NOTE:

- a) Candidates who have written both NATA and JEE Paper-2 entrance exams should upload both the marks card
- b) Candidate claiming KKR/HKR seat need to upload KKR/HKR certificate and Karnataka Domicile Certificate
- c) SC/ST/OBC candidates should upload SC/ST/OBC certificate and Karnataka Domicile certificate. Scan both certificates together as one document and upload
- a) All candidate should upload the original of their 12 STD/ 2nd PUC/ Equivalent marks card or Digi locker marks card with clear QR code. Candidates who do not have their original marks card or Digi locker marks card should download the marks sheet from their board website and get the seal and signature of their Principal/ Institution.

- I. **The size of the uploaded document file should not be more than 1MB (except for 12th marks card which can be up to 4MB)**
- II. **Documents should be uploaded in JPG, JPEG, or PDF format only**
- III. **Only clearly scanned images/ documents will be accepted**
- IV. **Photographs of documents taken from Mobile Phone will not be accepted**
