NOTIFICATION

Sub: UG Civil Engineering seats in The National Institute of Engineering, Mysore,

Pursuant to consensual arrangement between the Engineering colleges and the Government of Karnataka, 30% of the sanctioned intake in each college and course has been made available for being filled through COMEDK merit route. Accordingly, the Government earmarked 18 Civil Engineering seats in The National Institute of Engineering, Mysore vide its Notification in No. ED 73 TEC 2015 dtd. 12.06.2015. Accordingly, COMEDK has published its seat matrix showing 18 Civil Engineering seats in that college as being available and the candidates attending the first round of COMEDK counselling selected 16 of these 18 seats.

2. However, the Government of Karnataka subsequently on the ground that the Civil Engineering seats in The National Institute of Engineering, Mysore have since been treated as Government Aided Course, no seats in that discipline would be available to COMEDK and accordingly, directed its Agency (Karnataka Examination Authority) to fillup all the seats treating them as Government quota. In the result, 18 Civil Engineering seats earmarked earlier in favour of COMEDK ceased to be available to it. By the time these developments took place, the students attending the COMEDK counselling had already taken the seats.

3. Government taking note of the situation arising out of the above, directed KEA not to allocate any Civil Engineering seat in that college during its (KEA) second round and that those seats should be made available to COMEDK.

4. Nevertheless, COMEDK in the interest of justice, equity and fairplay to its students, has decided to offer the first opportunity of selecting Civil Engineering seats out of General Merit quota in the order of merit among the 16 candidates during its second round counselling in different colleges subject to availability of seats in the said discipline. Consequently there shall be an exclusive round of counselling on 24th July after Minority/ Hyderabad Karnataka round but before the General Merit round of Counselling for those students who had taken UG Civil Engineering seats during the first round of counselling in The National Institute of Engineering, Mysore.

5. However, if any of these students desires to opt for some other discipline in any college, such student should be counselled in the normal course in the order of merit.
